



## **Eddy K. Lefrançois Recreation Centre**

### **COVID-19 Rules – February 2021**

- Please use back entrance only to access and leave the building. The doors are accessible with ramp and electric doors
- Please bring your own water bottle, as the water fountain will be closed or will have limited access
- Please arrive dressed up/suited up in your equipment/gear 10 minutes before your practice
- Please make sure you have skate guards to walk in certain areas of the arena
- When you are done with your practice, activity or game, please leave the building right away, no loitering or mingling around
- The change rooms and showers are closed
- Part of the main lobby area/hallway will be closed
- The main public washrooms will be open and available, skate guards required
- There will be chairs spaced out in the hallway, if needed, to sit down to put on your last minute items
- Please access the ice via one door and exit via the other door, as indicated
- Please practice physical distancing (2 feet/6 metres apart) at all times everywhere throughout the facility, on and off ice
- Please wear your non-medical face mask in all accessible public areas of the building and during public skating on ice
- Please use hand sanitization stations as you enter the building and throughout the facility, keep your hands clean as much as possible at all times
- Other user groups, such as Minor Hockey, White Swan Figure Skating Club, etc. will have their own Safe Return to Play Protocols to follow on ice and within the facility per their own regulating associations
- Please be considerate and respectful with all users and municipal employees
- Please respect the 35 persons maximum indoors (25 persons on the ice surface)
- Please follow any signage advice that may be posted throughout the facility
- Sign in sheets will be required for all who access the facilities, for contact tracing efforts
- Please stay home and do not access the facility if you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms
- An isolation room will be available if anyone begins to experience COVID-19 symptoms during their time at the arena
- A fully stocked first aid kit will be available and on hand. Please ask the Recreation Assistant for access.
